## CARTMEL PENINSULA LOCAL HISTORY SOCIETY - DOCUMENT ARCHIVE - INDEX

- 1 The CPLHS has for many years benefited from generous gifts of documents, books and other artefacts. We are in the process of cataloguing these to form a CPLHS Document Archive so that these historical documents may be used by researchers with an interest in the local history of our peninsula.
- 2 The full record, as a detailed database, is being developed and will contain all the items we hold with a brief description of the item. It will be in the form of an Excel spreadsheet and will be searchable by Village, location, and subject using excel functionality. There will be pdf's of all items which are deemed suitable for this method of data capture.
- 3 The full CPLHS Archive will be available (date to be decided) on disc / memory stick in the future. The terms and conditions of availability of this document is still to be agreed by the CPLHS Committee.

After her father died in 1892 she lived there with her mother until the latter's death in 1918 when she moved to Kilnotts, Lindale. She taught at the Sunday school for over 30 years and was voluntary organist. She took great interest in the day school, was a manager, and for a long time correspondent. She was also a benefactor of Lindale Church.
